Our topics for this term are 'Transport' and 'Summer Holidays'

The following is a run-down of how we will be exploring these topic within the six areas of learning.

Understanding English, Communication and Language

Communication group: focusing upon taking turns and interacting with others, listening to others, cooperating and interacting with peers, making requests and describing objects.

Listening and responding to a variety of stories with a focus on Transport and Summer Holidays.

Individual English I.E.P targets.

Introduce and explore new vocabulary linked to our topic.

Fine Motor Skills sessions including Dough Disco.

Stage 2 of Phonics Song of Sounds where appropriate.

Share books with adults - individual reading where appropriate.

Mathematical Understanding

Individual Maths I.E.P targets.

Tally charts, pictograms, shapes, Number recognition and addition.

Scientific and Technological understanding

Looking at materials used to make different types of transport and how these move.

Looking at animals habitats linked to the seaside.

Understanding the Arts

Creating a range of artwork based on our topics. Collage, painting, sketching, chalks, junk modelling and playdoh to create different modes of transport and seaside scenes.

Understanding Physical Development, Health and Well-being

Dance - Music and Movement sessions - listening to a range of music and learning to move our body in a variety of ways in time to the music.

SAQ sessions: children will all have a daily session of SAQ to develop fundamental movement skills.

Listening to stories linked to our topics, where appropriate.

We will also continue our daily Sensory room, Language groups (including PECS) and Interaction group sessions.

As always, we will continue to keep you updated via Tapestry on a daily basis and let you know via there if children require any additional drinks/snacks etc.
